

Associate Pastor of Discipleship

Position Purpose: The Associate Pastor of Discipleship oversees adult ministries at Bethel Evangelical Free Church by shepherding, leading, and equipping adult Ministry Team leaders to fulfill the mission statement to love God, love others, and make disciples of Jesus.

Reports to: Senior Pastor

Position Status: Full Time

Evaluation: The AP will receive an annual evaluation by the Senior Pastor.

Compensation: Based on education, experience, and setting. Reviewed annually.

Direct Reports: Visitation Pastor. Adult Ministry Team leaders.

Job Description

Qualifications:

- He has a vibrant and growing relationship with Christ characterized by a life-style exhibiting commitment to the Scripture, prayer, spiritual disciplines, the fruit of the Spirit, and outreach.
- He meets the qualifications for elders as outlined in 1 Timothy and Titus.
- He demonstrates a high degree of theological knowledge and understanding. A degree from a Bible College or seminary is preferred, but not required.
- He has a good reputation with his family, at Bethel and in the community.

Job Duties:

- To meet on a regular basis with the leadership teams of Ministry teams so that he can shepherd, equip and give leadership to them.
- To help identify, recruit, and train new leaders for ministry.
- To work with the Senior Pastor and Elder board to assess and guide the disciple-making process and efforts of BEFC for adults.
- To partner with Children's and Youth Ministry so that parents and children are being disciplined and equipped in consistent ways.
- To preach in the Sunday services 4-6 times per year.
- To perform weddings, funerals, baptisms, and child-dedications, as well as to facilitate Communion on Sundays when he preaches.
- To be present and visible on Sunday mornings for oversight of ministry, connection with new people, or any needs that arise.
- To be investing in himself to stay relevant and current on ministry trends.
