

February 2023 Bible Reading Plan

Judges – a book that stands in contrast to the book of Joshua. In Joshua, an obedient people conquer the land by trusting in the power of God. In Judges, we read of seven distinct cycles of a disobedient and idolatrous people who are frequently defeated because of their rebellion against God. Notice how the “cycle of sin” begins as the nation’s spiritual temperature grows steadily colder.

1, 2, and 3 John – in 1 John the apostle discusses fellowship with God; in 2 John he forbids fellowship with false teachers; and in 3 John he encourages fellowship with Christian brothers. Godly character, love, and loyalty to the truth are never easy, but they bring God’s richest commendation.
