

March 2023 Bible Reading Plan

Ruth – a story of devotion and faithfulness of the life of Ruth, a Moabite widow who leaves her homeland with her widowed Jewish mother-in-law in Bethlehem and who becomes the great-grandmother of King David.

John – the fourth of the four gospels and different in some ways as John seeks to prove to his readers that Jesus is God in the flesh who has come to earth to die as God’s sacrifice for human sin.

Daniel – sometimes referred to as the “Apocalypse of the Old Testament,” presents a sweep of prophetic history where empires will come and go, but God will establish his people forever. Daniel is a young God-fearing Jew, exiled from his homeland and living in Babylon.
