

May 2023 Bible Reading Plan

***Psalms** is a collection of five books containing 150 poems. The fourth book is found in Psalms 90-106. In this section, all but three of the Psalms are anonymous. Psalm 90 was written by Moses, and Psalms 101 and 103 are written by David.*

***2 Thessalonians** – Paul exhorts the church in Thessalonica to remain steadfast and diligent as they wait on the Lord’s return.*

***Esther** – Esther’s life fits between chapters 6 and 7 of Ezra. The emphasis is on God’s hand of providence and protection on behalf of God’s people, though His name is never mentioned.*

***Haggai** – with the Babylonian exile now history, Haggai calls God’s people to renewed courage, holiness, and faith to finish the temple.*
