

April 2024 Bible Reading Plan

Zephaniah provides a forceful prophecy that may have been a factor in the reform which occurred during Josiah's reign – a revival that produced outward change but could not remove the inward heart issues that would continue to plague a nation.

Gospel of Matthew presents Jesus as Israel's long-awaited Messiah who brings the kingdom of God to earth and fulfills the prophesied promises of God from the past. Notice how often Matthew quotes from the Old Testament to create a bridge for his Jewish audience. Yet, Matthew closes with the Great Commission (28:18-20), which indicates Jesus the Messiah is available to all nations, both Jew and Gentile. Matthew probably wrote his Gospel in the 50s or 60s a.d.
