

## November 2024 Bible Reading Plan

**Leviticus** – God’s guidebook for his newly redeemed people, showing them how to worship, serve, and obey God and fulfill their priestly calling.

**Acts** – Luke begins where he left off in his gospel by recording the initial fulfillment of the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20 as he traces the beginning and growth of the New Testament church.

**Habakkuk** – a prophet who looks at his native Judah and observes violence and injustice on every hand, and cries out to God with some perplexing questions. What he will hear from God will be hard to swallow, but he eventually does accept God’s answer and simply rests in the hands of his sovereign God.
