

## January 2025 Bible Reading Plan

**Deuteronomy** – a farewell address from Moses to the new generation of Israelites, who survived the forty years of wilderness wanderings, who are destined to possess the Promised Land. Moses reminds this new generation of the importance of obedience if they are to learn from the sad example of their predecessors.

**Mark** – the shortest and simplest of the four Gospels. Mark lets the narrative speak for itself as it tells the story of the Servant Jesus who is constantly on the move preaching, healing, teaching, and finally dying for sinful men. The pattern of selfless service becomes the model for those who follow in the Servant's footsteps.
