James – “proverbs of the New Testament” it has been called. Faith without works cannot be called faith. Faith must move into action.

Joshua – the first of the twelve historical books (Joshua-Esther). The first half (1-12) describes the seven-year conquest of the land; the second half (13-24) describes the partitioning and settlement of the land.

Jude –

Obadiah – fighting between twin brothers (Esau and Jacob, Gen. 27) leads to national enmity between their respective people (Edomites and Israelites) and the destruction of Edom and the vindication of Israel.

Jude – the dangers of false doctrine and rebellion and how to overcome them.
